- C. Because God's favor is all I need (Genesis 39:2-6, 20-23; 41:37-43).
- D. Because I have a heritage from the Lord (Isaiah 54:13-17).

II. I am a magnet for God's creativity (II Corinthians 6:1).

- A. Because I am a co-worker with the Creator of the Universe who calls me His friend (II Corinthians 6:1-2; John 15:7-8, 15-16; Psalm 37:4).
- B. Because God has plans for me even when things are not going very well (Jeremiah 29:10-13; Romans 8:28).
- C. Because I am God's handiwork created to do works that God prepared in advance for me to do (Ephesians 2:10).

III. I am a magnet for God's wisdom (Psalm 32:8, 9).

- A. Because when I ask for wisdom, God gives it generously (James 1:5).
- B. Because God's anointing teaches me to obey His commands, I will always be the head and not the tail (I John 2:27; Deuteronomy 28:7-14; 30:11-16).

IV. I am a magnet for God's love (I John 3:1).

- A. Because the Father lavishes love on me as His child (Romans 8:14-16).
- B. Because no one can separate me from the love of Christ (Romans 8:31-39).
- V. Therefore, I will "Be joyful always, pray continually, and give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for me in Christ Jesus" (I Thessalonians 5:16-18).
