Paul is a Jew: Acts 22:3; Acts 26:4-7 Phil 3:4-8; 2Cor 11:22

Gamaliel was his Rabban – Elder in Hebrew Studies = Acts 5:38-39

- **Acts 21:39- Acts 22:1-21 – 2nd Time Paul told his Story in Jerusalem**

Note: Paul was called to suffer for His name – The name Jesus.

Like the Prophets: Jer 1:17-19; Ezk 2:3-8

- **Acts 26:1-23 - Paul telling King Agrippa his Testimony in Caesarea**

v.14 It is hard for you to kick against the goads! Resisting God's will!

Paul preached as he told his testimony to the King!! Turn and repent and turn to God.

1 Cor 15:1-15 The Gospel – Paul was called to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ

- Based on your encounters, you have a testimony, a story
- Your story becomes your unique calling by God
- God is calling – don't kick against the goads!
